Full-Time (1700 hours)	204 – 340 hours of training
Half Time (900 hours)	108 – 180 hours of training
Reduced Half time (675 hours)	81 – 135 hours of training
Quarter Time (450 hours)	54 – 90 hours of training
Minimum Time (300 hours)	36 – 60 hours of training

Site Supervisors should provide some trainings specific to their sites. If members receive trainings provided by the host site from other sources, these trainings count. Members may watch webinars, read books that are on topics related to their service to count for training. If member chose to do webinars or books, a report will need to be turned in and placed in your file. Any training that are attended at the member's site and sign in sheet and agenda will also turned in and placed in members file.
