







Reality Store is a simulation or game that helps students experience a tiny bit of real life as it applies to budgeting and making financial decisions for everyday life. In this game, students are approximately ten years out of high school or around 28 years old. They live in or around Scott County and work in the Louisville Metro area. Prior to Reality Store, the students worked with their Guidance Counselor to identify a career in which they are interested. Based upon their current GPA, their school attendance record, and there area of interest, they are assigned a "job" for the game. The Reality Store is part of Money Matters program.
